At £5 per head (maximum 2 per member) it is excellent value.

Following our request for help prior to and during events we have had a very positive response which has meant that setting up at both Danethorpe and Hackthorn was done in record time and extra stewards are being trained up for next season.

Our request for photographers was also well received and we managed to cover the dressage and all 4 obstacles at Hackthorn. The result was that Carol has had over 400 great pictures (still waiting for Obstacle 3) to sort through for inclusion on the web page!!! These were finally whittled down to about 80 which have now been uploaded to the web page.

The latest league tables have also been published and can be seen on the web page. Both the Novice and the Open leagues have been decided as only attendance points are allocated from the fun day.

As predicted in the last newsletter, Judith did up the ante by winning at Danethorpe but unfortunately had to withdraw from Hackthorn which meant that Richards' win at Hackthorn secured his place at the top of the Novice league - which means an exit from the Novice Class for next year into Open - keeping Joanne Gadsby in 2nd.

Mike Charlesworth won at both Danethorpe and Hackthorn and Carols' low score at Hackthorn saw Mike win the Open League and become Overall Champion by comfortable margins.

The AGM will be on Saturday 23rd November - venue confirmed as the Heneage Arms at Hainton.

Some of you might have noticed that at the beginning of this Newsletter we said that we were nearing the end of the Outdoor season, **NOT** the end of the Season. We are going to re-introduce, to Club driver members only, an Indoor Championship to be run at Tickhill in conjunction with IHDTA and Anne Chambers.

It will work as follows:

Indoor driving members will still enter their class in the normal way.

Non-members will send their entries to Anne (entry forms will be in the Indoor Driving page under the link to Events / South Yorks) and be entered in the Club class.

(Note: Entry to each event is \pounds 30. If, however, you send Anne a separate post-dated cheque for each event at the beginning of the Indoor season then the price is reduced to \pounds 25. Only 1 entry form is needed, showing the dates you wish to compete and the class you will be competing in).

All cheques to be made payable to IHDTA

Event dates are: Sundays:- 13th October, 3rd November, 1st December, 12th January, 2nd February, 2nd March.

Dressage Test available from IHDTA website.

Regardless of the Class entered, at the end of each event the scores for Poacher members will be extracted and re-collated separately, re-allocated points from 8 - 0 and rolled over to the end of the season when the winner of the Poachers Championship will be announced.
