Cones Driving clinic - "Get Inside a Course Designer's Head"with Richard Papens.

Richard Papens is a well known FEI International Course Designer and TD from Belgium. He gave a seminar at the Unicorn in 2009 and we have invited him back so you can get inside his head and discover that there is a science in setting out a cones course and not just placing a bunch of cones down in odd places around the arena.

Richard will help you understand what to look for when walking the cones, looking at the angles, see the rein changes, notice the circles.

Start at 9.30 for coffee, with the presentation at 9.45. The presentation will last until lunchtime, followed by a break for lunch.

The afternoon will be in the indoor arena, where there will be various cones set out for some guinea pig drivers, with one of our UKCC Coaches explaining, analysing, coaching and obtaining the feedback from the drivers on how they feel the course of cones went.
