#### BROCKLESBY

Although we have been to Brocklesby Park before, some years previously, this was a "new" venue for Poacher.

A superb location, set under the shadow of the 128 foot high Pelham Pillar, a landmark tower built by E J Wilson between 1840 and 1849, commemorating the planting of 12.5 million trees. The 1000 acre Park and woodlands were laid out in the 1770's by Capability Brown and the planting of the woodland was initiated by the First Baron Yarborough.

Preparation for this event started well in advance and by the time the "A" team of Mike C, John Gadsby, Richard, Carol, Kevin and Nigel (AKA "The Phantom of the Wood" as he could be heard driving up and down looking for his fellow course builders but nobody could see him!) arrived everything was in place ready for building the obstacles. ## INDOOR DATES

The dates for the Poacher Winter Indoor Championship to be held at Tickhill are as follows:

**2014**: 12th October, 2nd November, 7th December

**2015**: 11th January, 1st February, 1st March

**Entry Fee:** £30 per Event. If you enter in advance for all 6 events the entry fee is £25 per event

**How to Enter**: If you want to enter all 6 competitions, send a completed entry form to Anne Chambers, 2 Manor Cottages, Skegby Road, Normanton -on-Trent, Nottinghamshire, NG23 6RS, stating it is an entry for all and enclosed 6 post dated cheques for £25 each.

If you only want to enter individual events, then a separate entry form for each entry, accompanied by a cheque for £30 must be sent to reach Anne 10 days before the event.

You do not have to be a member of ICD UK to enter but in order to be eligible for the Poacher Winter Indoor Championship you must be a fully paid up member of Poacher Harness Club.

Entry forms for non ICD members and the dressage test are on the results page of the Club website.

To continue eligibility into 2015 all Membership renewals must be received by February 1<sup>st</sup> 2015
